Board of Trustees Special Meeting - April 24, 2017

The Board of Trustees of Joliet School District No. 7 held a special meeting on April 24, 2017, at 7:00 p.m. in the Joliet School Library Room. Board Members present were Melvin Stene, Justin Oswald, Kathy Grewell, Corie Mydland, Dawn Blain and Sharon Songstad. Doug Whitehead was absent. Also present were Allison Evertz, Superintendent and Sheryl Roberts, District Clerk/Business Manager and Marilyn Vukonich, High School Principal. Melvin Stene called the meeting to order at 7:00 p.m. followed by the Pledge of Allegiance. Mr. Stene welcomed guests and explained and asked for public comment. There was none.

Carla Amerson thanked the trustees for allowing her to work with the students during the last year and for answering the parents' concerns. She has concerns about gossip among staff and would like the trustees to look into the issue.

Supt. Evertz said Kathy Robinette has resigned and her letter is included in the board packet. She has requested a closed meeting with the trustees.

The meeting was closed at 7:30 p.m. The meeting reopened at 7:32 p.m.

Motion made by Dawn Blain to accept the resignation of Kathy Robinette. Motion seconded by Kathy Grewell. There were no public comments or discussion. Motion passed unanimously.
